

The Castle of Versailles

10 kilometres (6 miles) away from Paris, it is one of the most visited French monuments. Highly impressed by the Château de Vaux-le-Vicomte, designed for his minister Nicolas Fouquet, Louis XIV took inspiration from it and asked his architect,

Louis Le Vau, to enlarge into a palace, worthy of the Sun King, the hunting lodge built by Louis XIII.
